1. **WELCOME AND CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order at 5:01 p.m.
2. **ROLL CALL AND INTRODUCTIONS:** A quorum was present.
3. **MINUTES:** Approval of Minutes from Feb 10, 2022 - Jaime moved to approve the minutes with the amendment of removing the statement; Jaime E voted by absentee. Kym Gifford seconded the motion which passed by unanimous voice vote.

Approval of Minutes from March 29, 2022 – Jacque moved to approve the minutes as submitted. Kym seconded the motion which passed by unanimous voice vote.

4. **AGENDA:** The application for the HVAC renovation was removed by the applicants.
5. **APPLICATION REVIEW:**
 1. The Planning and Community Development Department is in receipt of an application from Michael Romney from The Wash. The applicant is requesting funding from the Small Business Support Program under the city façade program for new paint, new signs, and a new mural.

The applicant presented his project and stated that people have expressed that the new paint looks nice. The mural will remain for now. The next phase will include more

infrastructure. He presented a new quote for the paint that was higher than the previous quote.

Kym moved to approve the application for the updated amount requested. Jacque seconded and the motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

2. The Planning and Community Development Department is in receipt of an application from Kym Gifford from The Vignette. The applicant is requesting funding from the Small Business Support Program under the city façade program for storefront glass/new doors.

The applicants discussed rehabilitating the building and this will be the first step. There will be more infrastructure costs in the future. It will be a separate entity from the Venue.

Jacque moved to approve the application for the amount requested. Jaime seconded and the motion passed by unanimous voice vote. Kym did not vote as she is the applicant.
