Participants learn how to look for and document their family history using various resources. Sources covered so far include FamilySearch, Ancestry, Church and Census Records. Classes are Wednesdays from 5-7 pm until November 13th.

Constitution Night



The Daughters of the American Revolution hosted 66 individuals on Constitution Night September 18th. The program included the reading of the two winning scholarship essays from Safford High School, as well as the history of DAR family members who participated in the Revolutionary War.

Arizona State Library Training

The library hosted the LEAP Into Science Training on September 7th. Ten individuals attended the workshop, which provides educators with kits to offer programs in community settings like libraries, museums, and out-of-school time programs to underserved audiences. This year's topic is Wind, with most organizations going home with a starter kit focused on the concept. One organization also won a starter kit for balance, the focus of last year's Leap Into Science program.
