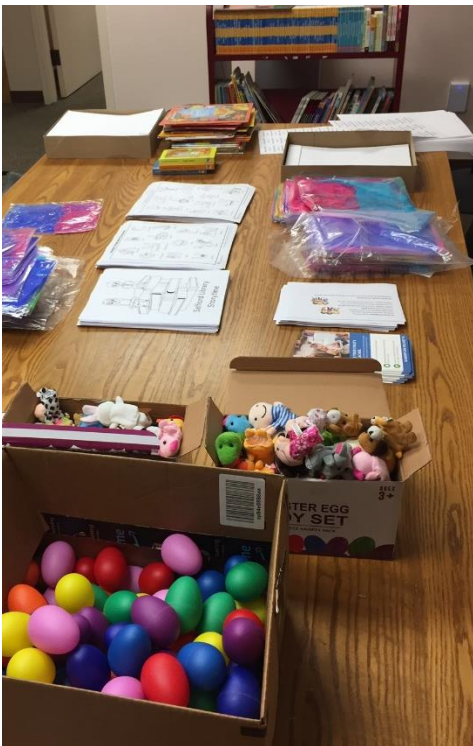


July 2020 Monthly Report

Back to School Resource Fair

For the Back to School Resource Fair on July 18th, the library provided school supplies and information about current services to be placed into each of the 500 backpacks given away. The information included hotspot checkout information, online tutoring services, and upcoming fall events and programs.



Summer Reading Program

As part of the reading program this year, the library distributed “Storytime Kits” for ages 0-5 years. Each kit contained an age appropriate book, egg shaker, scarf, finger puppets and song sheets as well as early childhood information for caregivers. The materials in the kit are used in storytime programs on Wednesdays at 11am. The library has given over 80 kits to local children.

The library also distributed 65 summer grab and go kits to the school lunch program to be given to elementary school students. The kits contained summer reading activities and craft supplies for simple crafts. The library provided an additional 102 summer reading kits and 80 book giveaway kits for elementary age children.

The library concluded the summer reading program on July 23rd. This year over 300 individuals registered for the program with all reading nearly 102,500 minutes from June 8th to July 23rd.

Individuals can pick up their prizes for reading minutes until August 20th.

New Scanning Station

Thanks to a donation from the Friends of the Library, there is now a scanner available to the public. The scanner suite includes a large format flatbed scanner and a document feeder. It also includes software that can do simple photo repair and can translate documents to and from several languages. It can scan documents to email, flash drive, Google Drive, Office 365, or phone and includes a document feeder. The scanner and document feeder will also be used for future genealogy programs to assist in documenting family histories.
