

ORDINANCE NUMBER O21-014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAFFORD, GRAHAM COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING TITLE 5 BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 5.24 TEMPORARY BUSINESS LICENSES OF THE *CITY OF SAFFORD MUNICIPAL CODE*.

WHEREAS, certain provisions of Title 5 Business Licenses and Regulations, Chapter 5.24 Temporary Business Licenses, were in need of amendment ; and,

WHEREAS, amending Title 5 Business Licenses and Regulations, Chapter 5.24 Temporary Business Licenses of the *City of Safford Municipal Code* establishes the temporary business license requirements and fees; and,

WHEREAS, the effective date of the amendment, dated January 10, 2022, shall be February 10, 2022, or upon completion of publication and posting as provided by law, whichever is later.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Safford, Graham County, Arizona, that the sections listed below of Title 5, Business Licenses and Regulations, Chapter 5.24 Temporary Business Licenses of the *City of Safford Municipal Code*, are hereby amended as follows:

5.24.070 - Fees and ~~special events~~ temporary businesses.

A. The license fee for a temporary business shall be ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ twelve dollars (\$12.00) ~~during any one quarter of the fiscal year and the license issued is valid for a fifteen (15) day period.~~ The fee shall be paid in advance. The amount of any fee in this section may be changed by resolution of the city council.

~~B. The license fee for a special event only shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) and the license issued is valid for a seventy-two (72) hour period.~~ A ~~special event~~ temporary business includes any parade, circus, festival, sporting event, entertainment, vehicle show, religious revival, political rally, ~~swap meet, special event~~ or other similar temporary activity that takes place under a common theme for a limited period of time. ~~The special event license fee is waived for annually approved events as set forth by the City Council.~~ A ~~special event permit~~ temporary business license is not required for any person whose activities or sales are casual or incidental in nature, whether for profit or not.


C. Renewal of the temporary business license ~~per event~~ is the sole responsibility of the ~~permit~~ license holder. Failure to renew a temporary business ~~permit~~ license prior to conducting business may result in denial of re-issuance of a temporary business license.

5.24.110 - Undue noises prohibited—Hours of operation.

Licensees, agents and employees of licensees and persons acting on behalf of licensees shall not yell, shout, cry out, blow a horn, ring a bell, or use any sound-amplifying devices, such as loudspeakers, microphones, radio, sound-amplifying systems, or any other similar devices for the purpose of attracting attention to any goods, wares, or merchandise if the sound emitted creates, permits, continues, or

permits to continue any unreasonably loud, disturbing, or unnecessary noise. Licensees, agents, and employees of licensees shall not conduct any business activities between the hours of eight p.m. of any day and the hour of eight a.m. of the following day **unless part of an approved event by the City.**


