

RESOLUTION NO. R22-004

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAFFORD, GRAHAM COUNTY, ARIZONA ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT FOR STATE FUNDS FROM THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ADOT) FOR THE PURPOSE OF AIDING IN FINANCING A PROJECT FOR DESIGN OF TAXIWAY A LIGHTING AT THE SAFFORD REGIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the City of Safford ("Sponsor") desires to secure grant funds for the design of the improvements at the Safford Regional Airport, Graham County, Arizona, and;


WHEREAS, the Arizona State Transportation Board, as approved on December 17, 2021, has authorized reimbursement to the Sponsor of funds expended for airport development, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Safford has sufficient City funds to provide local matching funds required for these improvements and to maintain the completed infrastructure, and;

WHEREAS, the maximum reimbursement available from the State to the Sponsor for this agreement shall be fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) and the minimum funding participation from the Sponsor shall be zero dollars (\$0), as determined by the State.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Safford, that the City Manager does have the authority to execute this ADOT Grant offered on February 2, 2022 under State Grant Number E2S4R 01C for the design of these Airport Improvements.
